

## Directions to Chestertown

For the air traveler, Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI) and Philadelphia International Airport provide the quickest (90 Min) and easiest access to Chestertown on the Eastern Shore of Maryland.

If you'll be traveling by automobile, the following directions should be helpful:

From Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and points North
Take 1-95 South to Exit 1B (Middletown. Delaware Route 896 exit).
Proceed on Route 896 South and merge onto Route 301 South. Exit Rt. 301 at Galena/Chestertown (Route 290 South); turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp. In Galena, proceed straight ahead at the stop light and continue on Route 213 South for 15 miles.

From Central and Southern Baltimore, DC, and Points South & West Take the route of your choice to Rts. 50/301 East and follow signs for the Bay Bridge / Annapolis. On the Eastern Shore, continue on Rts.50 / 301 East until they diverge in Queenstown; proceed North on Rt. 301. Exit Rt. 301 at Rt. 213 North and proceed for 15 miles.

## From Northern Baltimore

Take the Beltway (1-695) to 1-95 North. Exit 1-95 at North East and continue on Rt. 40 East to Rt. 213 South in Elkton. Make a right on Rt. 213 and continue South to Chestertown.
