Directions to Stepne Manor

Stepne Manor

From Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, and points North

Take I-95 South to Exit 1B (Middletown, Delaware Route 896 Exit). Proceed on Route 896 South and merge onto Route 301 South. Exit Route 301 at Galena/Chestertown (Route 290 South); turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp. In Galena, proceed straight ahead at the stop light and continue on Route 213 South for 15 miles. Make a right at the second light in Chestertown onto Morgnec Road. Then make a left at the stop sign onto High Street. Go to third light and make a right onto Cross Street. Go slow around the sharp bends and Stepne Manor will be immediately on the right hand side after the Stepne Station entrance. The Manor is across from Wilmer Park and the entrance is marked with brick pillars and a large black mailbox.

From Central and Southern Baltimore, DC, and Points South & West

Take the route of your choice to RT 50/301 East and follow signs for the Bay Bridge/Annapolis. Go over the Bay Bridge and stay on RT 301 to 213 North. Stay on 213 cross Chester River Bridge into Chestertown. Make a left at the first light onto Cross Street. Continue through the next light and go slowly around the sharp bends. Stepne Manor will be immediately on the right hand side after the Stepne Station entrance. The Manor is across from Wilmer Park and the entrance is marked with brick pillars and a large black mailbox.

From Northern Baltimore

Take the Beltway (I-695) to I-95 North. Exit I-95 at North East and continue on Route 40 East to Route 213 South in Elkton. Make a right on to Route 213 and continue South to Chestertown. Make a right at the second light in Chestertown onto Morgnec Road. Then make a left at the stop sign onto High Street. Go to third light and make a right onto Cross Street. Go slow around the sharp bends and Stepne Manor will be immediately on the right hand side after the Stepne Station entrance. The Manor is across from Wilmer Park and the entrance is marked with brick pillars and a large black mailbox.
